### How does my student get a work permit?

- 1. Student MUST have a job first. They should already have had an interview.
- Go to the HFHS main office and ask for the Worker's Permit for employer to sign. The secretary will explain what parts need to be filled out by employer and by parents.

# Where do students go in the morning before school?

The cafeteria (AKA High School Commons) is where students report before school starts. The cafeteria opens at 7:30 am.

### Do students pay for lunch?

No, students do not pay for lunch. Breakfast and lunch are free. If you would like to purchase from the snack bar, it does cost money. All freshman eat at the same lunch time, 1:00-1:30 and Wednesdays 12:20-12:50.

A food application must be filled out in skyward under the food services tab every year to keep the free lunches.

We do not allow any student food deliveries.

## If my child is absent, do I need to call in to excuse them?

Yes, please call the school by 10:00 am. If the student is not excused from school, you will receive a phone call letting you know that your child was not in school. Due to changes in truancy laws, excused absences will still count against attendance percentages.

### If my child comes in late to school, do I have to sign anything?

Yes, If you child is late to school or needs to be picked up early from school, a parent or guardian must come into the main office with a picture I.D. to sign the student in or out.

#### How do I check my child's grades?

- Enter your username and password
- 5. Click on gradebook on the left hand column

#### Is tutoring available for my child?

Yes, tutoring is available from 8:00 to 8:20 every morning and after school until 3:45 (no after school on Wednesdays).

#### How many credits are required to graduate?

Students will need 26 credits to graduate. Freshman have the opportunity to earn 7 credits this school year.

You may view your graduation requirements and which ones you have taken in your skyward account in the left hand column tab called Graduation Requirements (not available on phone ap). Check this periodically to make sure you are on track to graduate.
